

POLICY FOR WET WEATHER

If in doubt to club events going ahead, the following will assist you to find out

- Always check this website - in most cases we aim to make a decision no later than 12.30 pm on the Sunday - this is to allow for people who may be travelling to our club from such places as Nowra, Sydney and the Southern Highlands. We have several members who live outside of Wollongong and travel from these areas. The Executive aims to make the decision by 12.30 pm to allow enough time to air on 1.98fm.
- As mentioned above, tune into 1.98fm for sports cancellations.
- Beaton Park will make a decision in relation to the use of the interior. If the weather has been bad during the day or so beforehand and Council has closed all grounds, this could mean that the interior of the track only has been closed so a moderate program can be conducted which may be track events only. In most cases, we have been very lucky and have been able to use the track on most occasions.

We will not cancel any event unless the weather is very bad and we have full reason to do so. Sunday 18 September was a classic example of this, as the weather was bad and it was forecast that it would continue into the afternoon. Also, due to the Relay for Life being conducted on the track and bad weather hindering them being off the track by the scheduled time, was another reason for cancellation, but this is a rare event.
